

# ELECTRICAL SAFETY RECALL

## Numatic International Li-ion Battery Model 230211 & 604506 Li-ion Rechargeable Battery



### IDENTIFICATION:

Numatic International 36V 5200mAh Li-ion Rechargeable Battery. Black in appearance with model number and manufacturers serial number on silver sticker on side of the battery.

Sold as either a replacement unit or as part of RSB140 Battery Ruc-Sac Vacuum or NBV190 Henry Battery Vacuum. Affected serial numbers 201507000001 through to 201511999999 (bottom right panel of silver sticker, followed by a ■

The units were sold between October 2015 and May 2017 through Commercial Cleaning Retailers throughout Australia.

### HAZARD:

Under certain circumstances the battery noted above can build up an excessive amount of heat internally leading to smoke emission, scorching and deformation of the external case that could potentially cause a fire if the product is in contact with combustible material.

If the lithium-ion batteries overheat and discharge their contents, there is a risk of fire. (although there has been no known instance of overheating or fire in Australia)

### ACTION REQUIRED:

Consumers should stop using the battery immediately and return to their retailer for replacement or refund.
